COVID Policies/Procedures 2020-21 Season

Arrival Procedures

1. Be on time! Punctuality is crucial in order to properly enforce our safety procedures. Please arrive 5 min prior to class time for protocols to be met.
 2. No students will be permitted into the building after their class begins.
 3. Face coverings are required in our lobby and common areas. Once in their designated dance space they may remove their masks for dance. If you wish for your child to keep their mask on for the duration please let us know.
 4. Students must arrive in clean dance clothing. There will be no changing in the studio. Please make sure showered prior to coming to class. Hair must be pulled back and proper attire. We cannot pull back a student's hair so please make sure this is done prior to coming to studio
 5. Students are required to sanitize their hands before entering the studio lobby. We will have a staff member present to assist with this process.
 6. Students will place their masks, street shoes & belongings in designated spaces as assigned by BKC
- Note** Students in BB & PS classes will be permitted to have one parent enter into lobby to assist in removing shoes but will need to leave once the teacher brings students into class. No siblings will be permitted during this process.
7. Students will be escorted to a personal 6 x 6 space in the studio.

Note: If you are going to be joining us virtually -please be logged into zoom promptly. We cannot admit students late.

No one will be able to wait in lobby during class or enter lobby for pickup

Class procedures

1. All students will dance in 6 x 6 squares to ensure social distancing.
Class sizes for students 4 and under will not exceed 8 students.
There will be no physical contact between students at any time.
Any student who cannot follow the social distancing guidelines will be asked to leave the building and continue taking class via Zoom
2. Community mats/equipment use is on hold until further notice
3. Acro students should bring their own small personal yoga mat
4. There will be no food or eating allowed in the building by students.
5. Please try to use the bathroom before coming to class. Our bathrooms are always designated for one person and will be continuously sanitized throughout the night.

6. A designated staff member will be tasked with enforcing social distancing as well as frequent cleaning of all high-contact surfaces in accordance to our cleaning covid cleaning procedures throughout our hours of operation.

Dismissal Procedures

1. Parents/Guardians should arrive 5 minutes prior to pickup. We recommend parking and waiting outside studio for your child ages 3-7 Students will wait on designated spot until parent is there to check out. Please do not be late as it is essential for us to dismiss students, cleaning protocols and then new students will arrive. Students 8+ parents can pull up in front of building and we will dismiss as car pulls up to front door.
2. Students who wish to carpool must provide a written or emailed note of consent from both parent/guardians.
3. At the conclusion of class, dancers will be released one at a time from the studio room, retrieve their belongings and wait in the lobby on social distance spots for pick up
4. The lost and found has been removed. Any personal items that are left behind will be discarded at the conclusion of each evening.

Cleaning/Safety Procedures

1. The entire studio will be sanitized nightly by staff, and a deep cleaning will take place once a week.
2. There will be a designated staff member tasked with monitoring the safety and cleaning procedures during hours of operation.
3. Students will be mandated to keep their cellphones with their personal belongings in their assigned space. Parents/Guardians may call us at 860 691 0060 if they need to contact their student.

Exposure Procedures

1. In the event that any BKC student or family member contracts Covid-19, we will refer to the guidelines put forth by our local officials.
2. Students who test positive for Covid-19 must remain home until they have been cleared by a doctor and must provide documentation.
6. Students may only be in the studio when they are attending their registered class. Only students taking two consecutive classes may remain in studio from class to class. All other dancers must leave the studio at the conclusion of their class. This means if your student has an hour break between classes, they must be picked up by a parent/guardian and return at the time of their next class.
